


Inspired by the development of the colour palette and blanket for *Lattice* – a houndstooth rug also designed by Hella Jongerius – *Glory* combines colours to inspiring new effect with a patchwork design of multihued squares.

As uplifting as it is warming, *Glory's* construction, like *Lattice*, features a houndstooth graphic. However, flat woven using different yarns and colours in the warp and weft, a more complex rhythm and colour shift is apparent, and the final design is an expressive check that reveals many surprising colour combinations.

Whether seen from afar or up close, the colours swim delightfully in and out of focus, sometimes appearing fuzzy while never losing their vibrancy, making *Glory* a colourful rug that will brighten any interior.

Hella Jongerius

Hella Jongerius is one of the world's foremost product designers. She is a prominent force in the Netherlands, her native country, as well as on the international stage where she wins regular accolades for her thoughtful and research-driven work. Since her early work for Dutch design collective Droog, and now at her Berlin-based studio Jongeriuslab, material and process research largely determines her design direction. Her work has been characterised by a unique ability to approach industry with a craft perspective. In 2013 Hella Jongerius was appointed Design Director for Danskina, she has brought that same craft sensibility, research and experimentation to the textile industry.
