Bamboo

A lively and extremely individual rug made from shimmering bamboo viscose yarns.

Bamboo features a rich, compact structure, a long pile and exceptional colour richness. Designed by Ulf Moritz and Felix Diener, it has a distinctively light and playful expression.

Bamboo features a 40 mm pile and a particularly dense composition: every square metre contains over 1.8 million yarns. Consequently, the rug has a particularly vibrant look and feel.

The natural and sustainable bamboo viscose yarns used to construct *Bamboo* offer exceptional colour brilliance once dyed. They also ensure that the rug ages beautifully. Felix Diener: *"During usage the rug, with its naturally lively surface, develops a lovely patina: as some of the yarns lie down you get a beautiful silk-like shine."*

The bamboo viscose yarns also offer several other important benefits: they are naturally soft, durable, anti-static and highly sound absorbent. Plus, thanks to their excellent breathability, they also help to regulate the climate of a room: they absorb humidity when the air is too moist and replace it when the atmosphere starts getting too dry.

Bamboo comes in 18 elegant colours, which are contemporary interpretations of the hues found in ancient Persian rugs. These range from bold shades, such as deep pink and purple, to natural shades, such as beige and creamy white.

Felix Diener

Originally from southern Germany, textile designer Felix Diener creates rugs, curtains and accessories for the home. His acclaimed work, which forms an interface between art and technology, particularly stands out for its use of colour, materials and textures. As Felix Diener's portfolio reveals, his individual design philosophy extends far beyond colouring and shaping: his creative process is greatly influenced by the search for innovative structures, surfaces, compositions and production techniques.
